

What Is National Nurses Week 2024?

National Nurses Week is an annual event that begins on National Nurses Day, May 6, 2024 and ends on Florence Nightingale's birthday, May 12. To support and honor nurses around the nation, in 1998, May 8 also became National Student Nurses Day and we celebrate National School Nurses Day on the Wednesday that falls within National Nurses Week.

Each year, the American Nurses Association (ANA) leads the celebration to honor nurses. For the last few years, ANA has championed a month-long celebration to provide more opportunities to show appreciation for the invaluable jobs nurses do. In 2023, the ANA chose an evergreen theme, "You Make a Difference," to highlight the positive work nurses do and the impact they have on our lives. The organization has also designated May as "National Nurses Month" with four weekly themes: Self-Care, Recognition, Professional Development and Community Engagement.




