





Research Collections




KEY ELEMENTS

- Collection and shipping at the main site and/or subsites
- Direct contact between participant and site Connect staff
- Biospecimen survey sent to participant upon appointment check-in

- One (1) Data Source
 - Connect Biospecimen Dashboard
- Collection appointments conducted on-site by site Connect staff
- Pre-assembled collection kits with BPTLsupplied tubes:
 - (2) Serum Separator (SST)
 - (1) Lithium Heparin
 - (1) EDTA
 - (1) ACD
 - (1) Urine
 - (1) Mouthwash



Clinical Collections



KEY ELEMENTS

- Collection at clinics, shipping at main site
- No direct contact between participant and site Connect staff
- Biospecimen survey sent to participant upon specimen link

- Two (2) Data Sources
 - Connect Biospecimen Dashboard
 - Site Data System
- Collection tubes supplied by regional clinics:
 - (4-5) Serum Separator Tube (SST)
 - (2) Lithium Heparin
 - (2-3) EDTA
 - (1) Urine
- Tube size and quantity may vary



Home Collections (Coming Soon!)

KEY ELEMENTS

- Mouthwash collection method for clinical collections
- Instructions for collection and return shipment included in kit
- Mouthwash survey sent to participant upon kit shipment from BPTL

- One (1) Data Source
 - BPTL Dashboard
- Mouthwash kits assembled at BPTL, sent to participant's home, and returned to BPTL



- No involvement from Connect sites
- United States Postal Service (USPS) courier



Hybrid Model

- A single site offers participants the option to choose between a research setting and a clinical setting for sample collection
- The collection site is hybrid, not the collection
 - Blood and urine must be collected in the same setting (research or clinical)
- Kaiser sites will continue clinical collections only
- Non-Kaiser sites can/will adopt a hybrid model
 - Clinical processes can differ by site based on preference and resources
 - i.e., Collection tubes stocked at clinics vs. pre-assembled kits with BPTL-supplied tubes
